Lighting TD – Big Animation

Having a fairly strong background as an artist, at an early age, he chose to use his artistic skills to enter the film medium. Starting as a Photographer, he made his way slowly in the field of 3D animation.

At the age of 17, he ventured into the television medium and slowly worked up himself to become a cameraman. During this stage, he had involved in various projects like, Documentaries, Ads, Live shows, Blue Matte Shoots etc. With his strong interest in computers and the interest in the emerging animation industry, he entered into Pentamedia Graphics Ltd.

With his skills in composition, use of colors, lighting and exposure as a cameraman, he worked in various projects as a lighting artist. Some of his works include the 3D animated movies that Pentamedia did then. The company's venture into creating a channel for kids called "The Splash Channel" gave him yet another opportunity to fuse his knowledge of Television and Computer Graphics, making him head of the computer graphics team for the channel.

From there, Southern Spice music Channel, based at Chennai, took him to revamp the graphics in their Television channel where he worked for more than a year.

In 2003, Jadoo Works Animation Studio, based at Bangalore, hired him as a Sr. Lighting artist where he worked on a prototype called "Babe" with award winning director Garry Hurst, for Universal studios. Later he was bestowed the honor of heading the first team as the Lighting in-charge for "Higgly Town Heros", a project for Walt Disney. Apart from the TV series, he had worked in lighting department for various TV commercials that the company undertook. The "All out pluggy" AD went on to win the best animated AD of the year award in the year 2004.

Currently he is associated with Big Animation (formerly Anirights Infomedia Pvt. Ltd.), for their 3D animated Television series on Krishna, as the TD – Lighting, needless to say that Krishna TV series has already won more than 7 awards in various film festivals in India
